CONFIGURING IMAGES FOR DIGITAL PROJECTION

Images on CDs should be:

- Image Size: long dimension = 1024 pixels
- Resolution: 72 ppi
- File Format: JPEG
- Color Space: sRGB preferred
- Do not include other data on the CD.
- File name: 2 digits-first initial last name.JPEG

Example: 01-KDoyle.jpeg

FOR

PRINT DISPLAY

Print images should be:

- Image Size (whichever is larger): long dimension must be at least 10 inches
- or
- total image must be at least 80 inches square (8x10, 4x20, etc.)
- Mounted on a firm surface
 - Mounting surface may be temporary

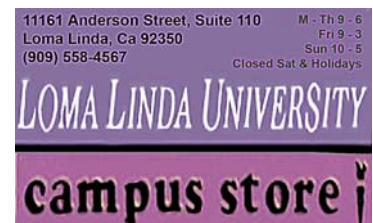
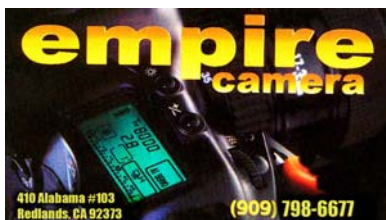
Please go by and say hi to the boys and tell them you are a member of the **Redlands Camera Club**. While there, tell them you would like to see the space available for hanging.

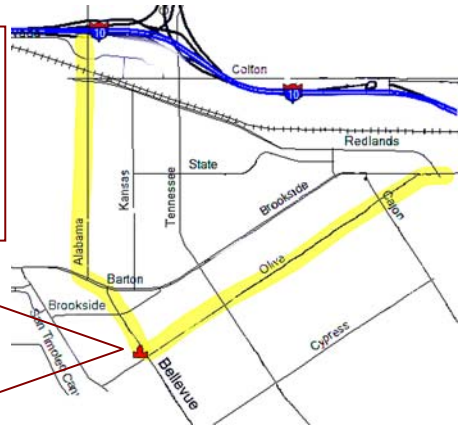
