
The next great field trip adventure: **Dia de Los Muertos** Saturday, Nov. 1st Olvera St., LA Check <u>www.olvera-street.com</u> for photos and information about the *Day of the Dead; c*lick on *Fiestas* and *Dia De Los Muertos*. Olvera Street is located between Union Station and the Music Center.

Arriving about 3:00 pm gives time to explore, photograph, and grab dinner before the procession. Activities will be from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Characters dressed for the occasion will be on the street, as well as photogenic memorials and vendor displays. Restaurants are in the immediate area. The *Novenaria Procession* begins at 7:00 PM.

There are opportunities to use available light as well as flash. Travel light! Monopods are good for this type of shooting. You will want to keep your eye on your gear at all times, as it gets pretty crowded.

The work must be yours, a member of RCC. It must be ready to hang using wire eyes & wire; <u>no saw tooth hangers</u>. You may use a frameless presentation, but it must be glazed (glass over the picture). Your name, title of the picture, and sale price (if for sale) must be on the back. There is a \$3.00 fee for each work hung: cash or check. Work left for another hanging will be charged again. Work not retrieved after a new hanging will be charged a \$3.00 storage fee.


