The upcoming Members' Night may help. Submitting images for critique is a good way to learn how to improve the quality of an image. Better cropping, better composition, and better editing all go hand-in-hand with good photography.


**William Liles** was introduced to photography by his mother, a professional photographer, but did not become seriously interested until recently, when he retired from the real estate property business.

Special file naming protocol for scavenger hunt only.

**<u>01</u>** is the category **-<u>Sept08</u>** is the date **-<u>JReece</u>** is your first initial & last name

This naming protocol will group all of the pictures together by category. Images are to be entered on a Windows readable CD. Each image file must be in sRGB color space and JPG format, with a file size of less than 3000KB (3MB). Resolution should be 1280 pixels on the long side and no less than 72 ppi.


