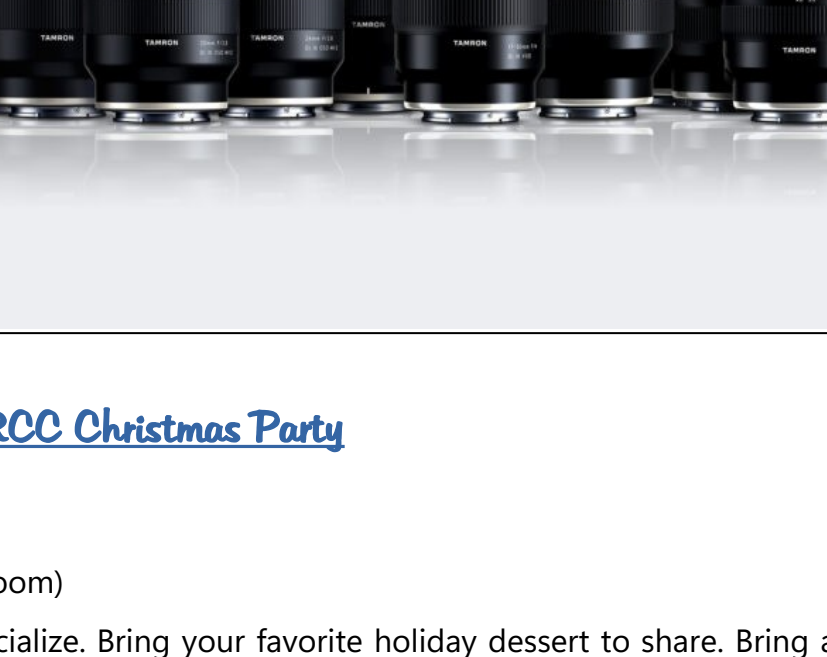
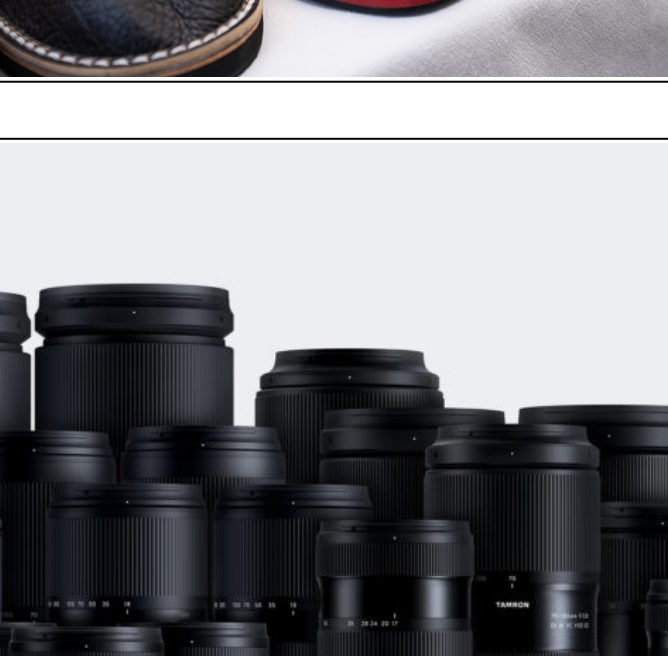
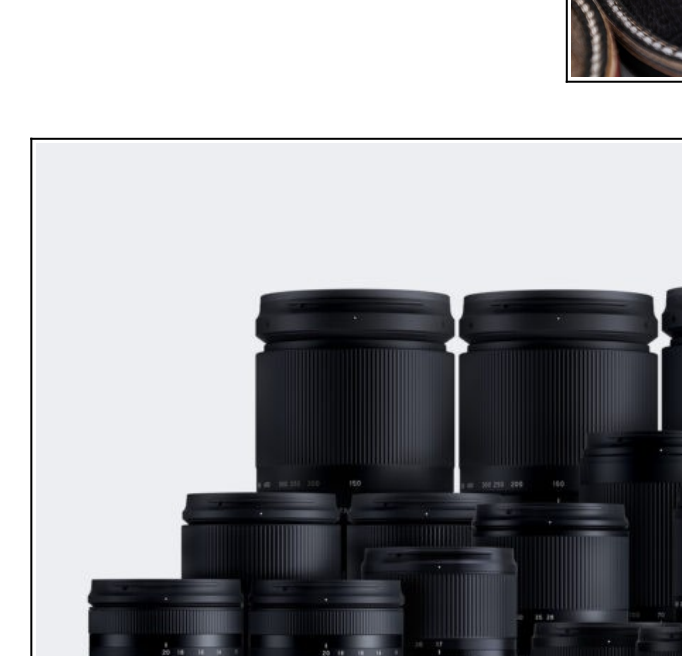
In Person & Zoom Meeting – Armando Flores

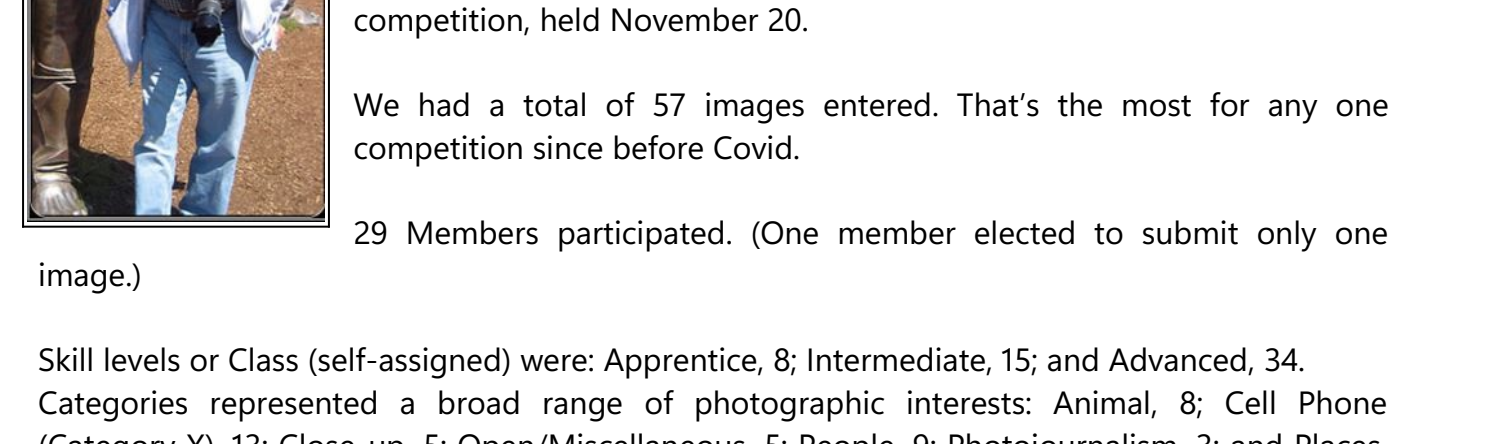

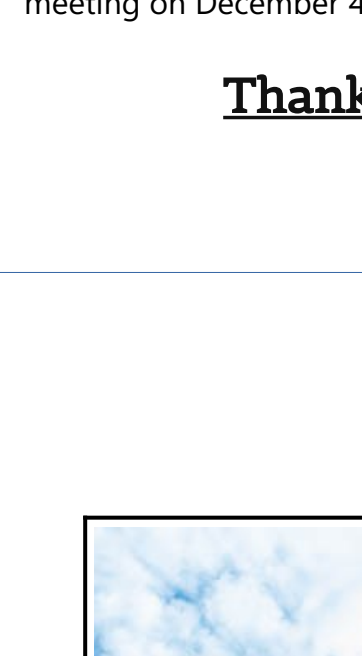
No Club Meeting January 1

We had a total of 57 images entered. That's the most for any one competition since before Covid.

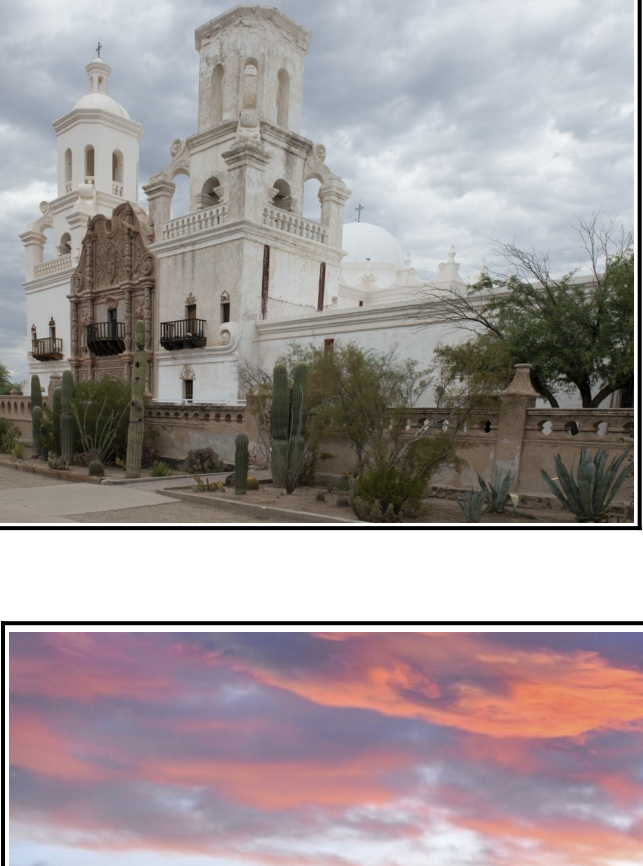
29 Members participated. (One member elected to submit only one image.)

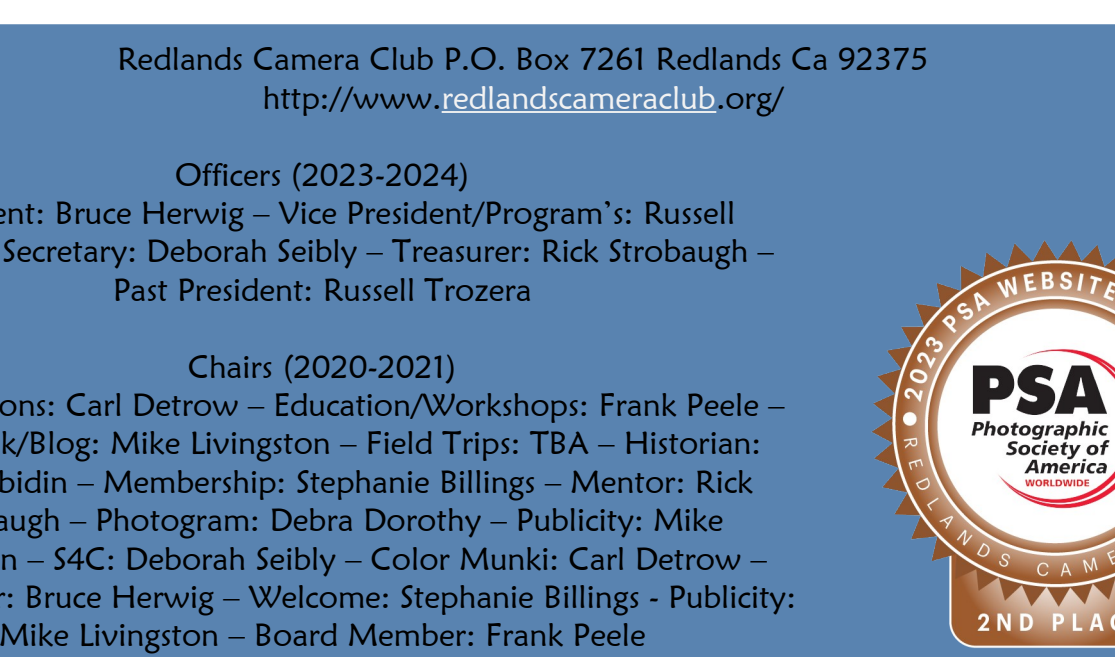
The Theme for the January Photogram is
